Project name	Bowdens Silver - Community Quantitative Study
Project reference	NGR 2209001
Research dates:	9 th November - 4 th December 2022
Target population:	The target population for the research was residents living in the Mid-Western Regional Council LGA in New South Wales, aged 18+.
Research methodology:	The research comprised of a 20-minute computer assisted telephone interview (CATI) among n=407 participants.
Weighting approach:	The data was weighted using ABS Census population statistics on age, gender, postcode and level of schooling completed to match the 18+ population. The total effective sample size after weighting was approximately 70%, equating to a margin of error of approximately +-5.9% (at the 95% confidence interval).
Research questions:	A combination of single choice and open-ended questions were used in the research.

- Bowdens Silver is a local resource company 100% owned by Silver Mines Limited, an Australian public company listed on the Australian Securities Exchange.
- If approved the Bowdens Silver Project would be an open-cut silver mine approximately 26 kilometres east of Mudgee, near the town of Lue.
- The Company will mine silver and also by-products including zinc and lead over 16.5 years and the project is Australia's largest undeveloped silver project.
- \$250 million dollars will be invested to build the mine.
- Bowdens Silver currently employs 24 people, with the vast majority being locals from Lue, Rylstone, Kandos, Mudgee and surrounds. If approved, this will grow to over 320 jobs during construction and 228 ongoing jobs for local communities.
- Bowdens Silver's Community Investment Program will continue to support local schools, clubs, events and initiatives throughout the life of the project, with over \$500 thousand dollars spent to date.
